Welcome to the end of the first quarter of 2020-2021 school year. It may have been a different type of journey to get here, but that does not cloud our sense of excitement at starting a new quarter with opportunity to see many of our students.

Although there is nervousness about the unknowns of this school year, the preparation and planning to welcome students safely and warmly--whether virtually or in-person has guided us every step of the way. We will use the next two days to hone our procedures and protocols. Please know, our staff could not have prepared any better! A few reminders as we start the week.

Skyward Wellness Screener

All parents of children attending **in-person school MUST** self screen their child before school each day. Watch the helpful demo videos to find out how to use the Skyward Wellness Screener, which can be accessed through your Skyward parent portal. You can also access the screener on the Skyward app, which can be downloaded onto your smartphone. ***We are asking all parents sending their student(s) to school in-person to log-in and view this self-screener.*** This is an important item and it is absolutely essential that parents complete it each day. Once school starts there will be a reminder text and email at 7 a.m. each day. Students who do not have a completed screener will be pulled from class and parents contacted. School staff are not permitted to complete a screener for students; only parents/guardians can complete this mandatory daily screener necessary for in-person learning. If you cannot access the electronic version of the self screener, you may print out and complete the paper version attached in this email. I have provided three rudimentary videos. Forgive the unpolished but practical approach as I did them myself. You will find them in the attachments.

- How to login to Family Access if you are new to the district or forgot your username/password
- How to submit the Wellness screening question in Skyward Family Access
- How to use Skyward Mobile Phone App

If you have never accessed Skyward in our district, you should have received a mailing with a login and password a few days ago.
