Proof of Residency Requirements for Shiloh Village School District #85 New Student Registration

As approved by Shiloh Village School District Board of Education, June 2012

Residency of a student enrolled at Shiloh Village School District #85 is determined by where the child sleeps, eats, bathes, and dresses each day and night. If a child lives with someone other than his/her custodial parent or registered guardian, an affidavit must be signed, which is a legal document, declaring that the child lives at the residence for reasons other than attending school. Falsifying information on the affidavit will result in the immediate withdrawal of the student from school with legal action following.

In order to register a child at Shiloh Village School District, **three** proofs of residency must be shown as well as the **child's official birth certificate**. Parents or legal guardians should bring three of the following forms of registration to satisfy the residency requirement:

Group A: At least one proof of residency MUST come from this group.

- Current Lease or Mortgage
- Current Homeowner's Insurance/Rental Insurance
- Current property tax receipt (with owner occupied exemption)

Group B: No more than two proofs of residency may come from this group.

- Current utility bill (within the last two months)
 - Water
 - Gas
 - Electric
 - Landline Phone – Wireless will not be accepted
- Voter registration card

*A driver's license **will NOT** be permitted as a valid form to prove residency.

The administration has the right to make periodic home visits throughout the year to verify student residency.

If at any time, a family is homeless contact Mr. Dale Sauer, Superintendent for additional resources and services.

Note: *Any person who knowingly enrolls or attempts to enroll in the schools of a school district on a tuition free basis, a student known by that person to be a non-resident of the district, or any person who knowingly or willfully presents to any school district any false information regarding the residency of a student for the purpose of enabling that student to attend any school in that district without the payment of a non-resident tuition charge shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor. Anyone who knowingly or willfully provides false information on this form shall be referred for criminal prosecution. A CHILD'S LEGAL RESIDENCE IS WHERE HIS/HER LEGAL GUARDIAN RESIDES. Shiloh District #85 has the right to investigate your residency.*
